

FOXBERRY VILLAGE POOL RULES & REGULATIONS

Safety is the primary concern of the Board of Managers. These Rules will be strictly enforced:

- 1. Any Person using the pool area does so at their own risk and sole responsibility. Foxberry and the Foxberry Board of Managers/Management do not assume responsibility for accidents or injuries in connection with such use. The Owner/Resident agrees with the Board of Managers/Management for and in consideration of the use of the pool to make no claim against Foxberry Village Condominiums or the Board of Managers/Management for or on account of any loss or damage of life, limb, or property.**
2. All Unit Owners/Residents must familiarize themselves with the location and use of the rescue equipment, the emergency phone and the rules and procedures of the pool.
3. Only Owners/Residents who have registered as a Pool Member and been issued a key to the pool gate can enter the pool enclosure. The pool gate and restroom doors must be closed after entering or exiting and must remain closed. Upon exiting the pool enclosure the pool gate must be locked. The gate should not be opened for persons without a key.
4. Every Person is required to sign the Pool Book upon entering and exiting the pool enclosure. This includes Owners, Residents, Family Members and Guests.
5. Owner/Resident must accompany and remain with their guests in the pool enclosure. The Owner/Resident and 3 family members or guests are allowed in the pool enclosure (maximum of 4 people per unit).
6. Entry into the pool enclosure and use of the pool is only during the posted hours of operation. Current hours are 8am-9pm but hours are subject to change. Entry in the pool enclosure after 9pm or before 8am or when the "Pool Closed" sign is posted on the gate is considered trespassing and may be prosecuted.
7. Pool area and the pool should be cleared during inclement weather or when the pool is closed. Reentry can occur 15 minutes after the last lightning strike.
8. No children under the age of 16 will be permitted in the pool or pool enclosure unless accompanied by a responsible ADULT who must supervise the child at all times.
9. No alcoholic beverages, food, or breakable containers allowed in the pool enclosure. No obviously intoxicated persons or persons under the influence of drugs are allowed in the pool enclosure.
10. No person with an infectious or communicable disease or open wound or rash is allowed to use the pool.

11. The Condominium/HOA is not responsible for the loss, theft or damage to any personal property in the pool enclosure. All personal items must be removed when leaving the area.
12. Pets are not permitted in or around the pool enclosure and must not be leashed to any common element.
13. All persons must wear proper swimwear to enter the pool area. Thong style bathing suits do not constitute proper swimwear.
14. No diving is permitted in the pool.
15. No running, pushing or rough-house play or bikes or other toys or devices with wheels allowed in the pool enclosure. No abusive or profane language or behavior that is disturbing to other Pool Members is allowed in the pool area. Only music devices used with earbuds/headphones are allowed in the pool area.
16. No balls, rafts, or floating objects are allowed in the pool enclosure except for one pool noodle per swimmer. Pool noodles must be removed from the pool area upon leaving. Oily or greasy suntan lotions must be toweled off before entering the pool.
17. Urinating, expectorating, or blowing the nose in the pool is prohibited.
18. Rescue equipment in the pool enclosure is not to be used for any purpose except rescue.
19. No diapered babies are allowed in the pool.
20. Pool Members shall leave the pool area neat and clean by disposing of garbage in the trash and removing all personal property from the pool enclosure.
21. Only management is permitted in filter/equipment supply rooms.
- 22. Owners/Residents must make sure the pool gate is securely closed and the pool gate locked after the last person exits the pool enclosure.**
